How to create a phonemes game to develop learners' pronunciation skills

CEFR level: Any level

Exam task focus: GESE and ISE

Aims:

• To create a game to focus on challenging phonemes

Procedure:

- 1. Create a table in either Word, or Google docs. (3 x 6 or 4 by 8). Insert > Table > number of columns and rows.
- 2. Think of examples of words with the sounds that you want learners to focus on i.e. /I/ and /i:/, or /s/ and /3/.
- 3. Think about how the phoneme can be represented when it is the written form.
- 4. Insert a path of words with the sound you want learners to focus on from the beginning to the end of the maze first. Remember these words can be next to/above or below, but not diagonally.
- 5. Remember to indicate clearly where the maze begins and where the maze ends.
- 6. Now, fill in the rest of the spaces to complete your maze.
- 7. Encourage your learners to make their own phoneme mazes and share themwith their friends.
